The Hoodland Women's Club is "Helping the Whole Community"

The Hoodland Women's Club was founded in 1963 as a service club. The club focused on service to the Hoodland community after the effects of the timber layoffs, and in 2004 received a 501(c)(3) designation. Our goal is to help the community we live in, and promote the purpose of the club through planning and responding to community service needs.

The HWC Community Fund is available to Hoodland neighbors to meet immediate physiological needs.

<p>Who is eligible?</p>	<p>Any Hoodland neighbor (Hoodland area includes the Welches School District boundary)</p>
<p>What is the fund intended for?</p>	<p>The community fund is specifically to help neighbors meet immediate <u>physiological needs</u>. <u>Physiological needs</u> are biological requirements for human survival, examples include, but are not limited to food, water, shelter, or medication.</p>
<p>Are there any requirements before I submit a request?</p>	<p>Persons requesting funds are asked to have inquired with at least two other organizations before submitting an HWC request. The HWC has compiled a Hoodland Community Resources List which can be found on our website!</p>

You can also obtain a paper form at one of these community locations: Hoodland Library, Hoodland Senior Center, or Neighborhood Missions.</p> <p>Once a request is completed, a member of the Women's Club will contact you to confirm eligibility and share more information about the process.</p> <p>If you have questions about eligibility or need help completing the form, email INFO@HOODLANDWOMENSCLUB.ORG.</p>
<p>Is there a limit to the funds provided?</p>	<p>There is a maximum \$500 annual limit per household, if approved and as funds allow.</p>
<p>How quickly can approved funds be provided?</p>	<p>The HWC will make every effort to review and process requests as soon as possible. Community circumstances and the USPS mail service can also impact requests. Our goal is to determine all requests within two weeks.</p>
